## About Us

Rocky's K9 Rescue was set up by Merna Karam to save dogs and cats from a death sentence in the pounds in NSW. Our aim is to re-home good and deserving animals with a new family for the rest of the pet's life.

Rocky's K9 rescue does not profit from fees, or pay wages. Our rescue is staffed by volunteers. Money raised from events and donations are used in direct aid for the dogs, cats and other animals.

Rocky's is staffed by a dedicated team of volunteers who work as foster carers, transport the animals, work on fund raising campaigns, administration, website & posters. They also work with the prospective new families.

In summary, donations are spent on the following:

- Boarding kennel fees
- Veterinary fees- desexing, vaccination, health checks, treatments, micro- chipping, worming etc....
- Intestinal worm and Heart worm treatment and prevention
- Dog food, cat food- dry food, wet food
- Flea treatments, Flea prevention
- Medicated shampoos, flea shampoos
- Dog ear cleaners
- Dog collars, dog leads and dog beds
- Kennels, beds, towels & bowls
- Cat collars, toys, cat litter
- Toys & balls



## Adopt an Animal

Adopting your new pet, cat or dog, will be the beginning of a lifetime of love, joy and companionship. Please only consider adoption if you are ready for a lifetime commitment.

All of our dogs and cats up for adoption have a brief description of their personality and temperament, together with their photo.

All of our dogs and cats have had the following Procedure and Treatments:

- Vet checked
- Desexed
- Vaccinated
- Micro chipped
- Heartworm tested + Prevention (dogs only)
- Flea treated
- Wormed intestinally
- Flea prevention

Most of these dogs and cats have been rescued from council pounds or have been surrendered to Rocky's.

It will normally take a few weeks for a dog or cat to settle into a new family, new rules and a new routine. This will require patience and quite possibly involve a whole lot of fun!

There is a 2 week trial period for all dogs taken for adoption from Rocky's K9 Rescue. If, at the end of the 2 week period you do not feel that the adoption is successful, Rocky's K9 Rescue will take the dog or cat back into its care, and refund your adoption fee.

If, at any time in the future your circumstances change and you are unable to care for your pet, please contact Rocky's K9 Rescue as we will always take back one of our rescue dogs or cats.

The final decision to allow a dog or cat to be adopted is always at the discretion of Rocky's K9 Rescue.

## How can you help?

Of course we could not do our work without our volunteers, foster carers, sponsors' support, media and community donations. Rescue really is a team effort.

We are always in need of volunteers to spend time with the animals, or foster carers to provide temporary homes to those pets who need more time to find the right home.

We require ongoing help in the following ways:

### Foster Carers

Are always needed. The more foster carers we have, the more dogs and cats we can rescue. Foster carers make rescue work possible. If you would like to know more about becoming a foster carer please contact us.

### Volunteers

We are always in need of volunteers to spend time with the animals with walking, feeding and giving love to our doggies.

### Special Events

We hold regular events in order to raise awareness and also funds for our charity. We are always in need of volunteers to help with the running of these events.
